9th Century Saxon

Much more than a decorative embellishment as found on many other replicas, Hanwei's take on this early Saxon blade is authentic to the core. The blade features a high carbon edge and pattern-welded core that was a technique used by the smiths at the time to create a resilient, sharp and highly decorative blade for the well heeled nobleman. Now CAS Hanwei has made these blades affordable as well. The sword's design is based on a 9th Century piece found in the bank of a stream in England in 1976 and now on display in the Yorkshire Museum.
