





## Palnatoke.<

A Back Mount consists of:

- a) Back mount plate.
- b) 2 Back mount Straps.
- c) Nylon lace.

Pull the straps through the rings as illustrated in step two

Tighten and fasten the leather straps through the leather rings. Do this on both sides.

Back mount assembled:

The Straps should fit tightly around the shoulders and not need to be further adjusted. Hence when putting on or taking of the Back mount, this should be done with both arms simultaneously, by raising them above your head.

A quick release set consists of:

- a) Back mount.
- b) Back sword holder.
  - c) Quick release pin.
  - d) Quick Release string.

Divide the nylon lace in two equally long pieces and cut. Burn the ends slightly to avoid the lace unravelling.

Using the top five holes on the Back mount; pull the lace through the holes, from rigth to left, starting from inside the Back mount. Then pull the lace back through the holes, ending one hole from where you started.

Tighten and tie the two ends together. Repeat the same steps on the bottom of the Back mount.

Finally, attach the Quickrelease string around your swords cross guard as illustrated.
Ajust the length of the lace to get a smooth release.
